

SOME DIFFERENCES:

SOME SIMILARITIES:

CHRIST AND CHURCH **Colossians** is polemical, i.e. written from a WRITTEN AROUND THE SAME TIME • argumentative/apologetic/or (BOTH ARE PRISON EPISTLES) defensive viewpoint against TRANSMITTED THROUGH SAME • Gnostic heresy while **Ephesians** is **MESSENGER--TYCHICUS** irenical, i.e. peaceful/conciliatorypresenting positive truths. **Colossians** is **CHRISTOLOGICAL**— Mostly about Christ, the Head presenting Christ as the true (unreflected as the sun to the moon) "fullness" of the Godhead, while **Ephesians** is **ECCLESIOLOGICAL**— Mostly about Church, the Body presenting the Church of Christ as the *reflected* (as the moon to the sun) "fullness" of Christ


Ephesians 1:17-20—ENLIGHTENMENT


- God would give the readers the Spirit of wisdom and revelation
- That the "eyes of their heart" would be enlightened
 - o 1. To know God
 - o 2. To know the **hope** of his calling
 - o 3. To know the riches of God's glorious inheritance in the saints
 - 4. To know the exceeding greatness of his power towards believers (the power that led to Christ's physical resurrection, and ascension AND that resurrects individuals from spiritual death to life)

Ephesians 4: 1—EXHORTATION

• That the believers would "walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which [they] have been called"

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Ephesians 3: 1

Eph 3:1 For this reason I, Paul, a prisoner for Christ Jesus on behalf of you Gentiles—

FOR WHAT REASON?

FOR THE REASON MENTIONED IN EPHESIANS 2 AND ALSO MENTIONED IN CHAPTER 1

DO YOU REMEMBER THE REASON?

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The phrase "for this reason" reminds us of Ephesians 1: 15-16

Eph 1:15-16 For this reason, because I have heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus and your love toward all the saints, I do not cease to give thanks for you, remembering you in my prayers,

Paul has reason to give thanks and to pray for his readers in Ephesus and environs: Eph2:10 For we are his workmanship

THE REASON is in 2 parts:

1. Their FAITH

Eph 2:10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.

- o This confirms that they are recipients of spiritual blessings (Ephesians 1: 1-14)
- 2. Their LOVE TOWARD ALL THE SAINTS
 - This confirms that they are God's workmanship created in Christ Jesus exhibiting the purposed end of their new creation in good works, namely love towards all the saints (Ephesians 2: 10)

OUR WEALTH OUR INHERITANCE

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THE TREASURE CHEST opens to "EVERY SPIRITUAL BLESSINGS IN THE HEAVENLY

PLACES IN CHRIST JESUS" (Ephesians 1: 3)

Gal 4:4-7 But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth his Son, born of woman, born under to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might receive And because you are sons, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!" So you are no longer a slave, but a son, and if a son, then an heir through God.

THIS INCLUDES THE BLESSINGS (in CHRIST) OF:

- The FATHER (Eph. 1: 4-6)
 - Choosing/Selecting those who would be His ELECT, before laying the earth's foundation, for the purpose of them being holy and blameless before Him
 - Lovingly setting the Destiny of the ELECT in ADOPTION as adult sons and therefore heirs (this has to do with being heirs and thus being predestinated for receiving an inheritance—rather than REGENERATION, the new birth)—according to the purpose of His will.

• ACCEPTING the elect "in the Beloved"— (Thus accepting us as He would accept His beloved Son) cf. Paul, Philemon & Onesimus [Philemon 1: 17] THE TREASURE CHEST opens to "EVERY SPIRITUAL BLESSINGS IN THE HEAVENLY PLACES IN CHRIST JESUS" (Ephesians 1: 3) THIS INCLUDES THE BLESSINGS OF:



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The SON (Eph. 1: 7-12)

In whom we (the ELECT) have REDEMPTION (are purchased from the slavery of sin) through His blood (as the price of purchase)

- The value of the price places a value on the purchase (1 Peter 1: 18-19)
- EXTRINSIC versus INTRINSIC value In whom we have FORGIVENESS of our sins, according to the riches of God's grace,

In whom we have obtained an INHERITANCE- (due to the fact that we were indeed destined beforehand by God, who works all things according to the counsel of His will, to fulfill His purpose)

Redemption

Time Magazine Online Edition, November 14, 2012 Let us illustrate Our Redemption with this This abstract painting by Mark Rothko has some INTRINSIC VALUE. When Rothko first painted this, it's size, its colors, it's statement carried and still carries an intrinsic value. If we put the price in dollar value, it would very likely be in the thousands of dollars, not in the millions. 2. If someone accidentally poured tar over this painting, you could imagine that the painting would lose much of its intrinsic value. Thankfully no one did. Today someone has put an EXTRINSIC 3. VALUE to the painting that the painting likely did not have intrinsically. By placing 75.1 million dollars as the 4. EXTRINSIC VALUE of the painting, the VALUE of the painting has risen to the price paid,, namely 75.1 million dollars. This is not the INTRINSIC worth of the painting—in fact relatively the painting has no intrinsic worth compared to the price paid. EXTRINSICALLY, however, the value of the price signifies value of purchase and this painting has ACQUIRED tremendous value due to the

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Redemption

THE REDEMPTION OF HUMANITY: 1. When God created us, He created humanity in His image as male and female. (Genesis 1: 27). This put an INTRINSIC value to humanity that was tremendous, greater than any other earthly created entity. The Psalmist stated that humanity is just a little lower than angels and that we are "crowned with glory and honor" (Psalm 8: 5). God Himself surveying this masterpiece of His creation assessed that His creation was However humanity's INTRINSIC VALUE fell when sin entered the 2. human soul (Genesis 3). What was considered "very good" by God had became significantly tainted. It was not only as if tar was poured over this masterpiece, tar bubbled within the masterpiece thus killing it (Romans 5: 12). "Falling short of God's glory" was akin to going from a worth of billions of dollars to maybe 10 dollars (Romans 3: 12). Our INTRINSIC Value is greatly diminished, albeit still present to some extent. When Christ purchased us back, our relative INTRINSIC worth was non-3. existent. However due to the price paid, namely His own precious blood, our value has risen EXTRINSICALLY to the value of the price paid (1 Peter 1: 18-19). But He did more, He also, according to the riches of His grace, forgave our sins, removing every stain of the tar that bubbled within. So that now, for those who are His elect, those who believe in Him and know Him, not only has the ORIGINAL worth been restored, our worth is far more because of the price paid. We now have EXTRINSIC worth equal to the value of the PRICE paid, namely Christ's precious blood and an INTRINSIC worth as well. WE ARE VERY VALUABLE TO GOD, i.e. PRICELESS—so valuable that a price cannot


Ephesians 2:13 -16 But now in Christ Jesus you who once were **far off have been brought near** by the blood of Christ.

Ephesians 2: 18-22

For through him we both have access in one Spirit to the Father.

So then you are **no longer strangers and aliens**, but you are **fellow citizens** with the saints and **members of the household of God**,

built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus himself being the cornerstone,

in whom the whole structure, being joined together, grows into **a holy temple** in the Lord.

In him you also are being built together into a dwelling place for God by the Spirit.

What triggers the Parenthesis of Ephesians 3: 2-13 is possibly the word "prisoner" in verse 1. Paul carries the idea of his being a prisoner in verse 13 "what I am suffering". After verse 13, Paul continues the statement of verse 1 which he started with, "for this reason" in verse 14.

Why the Parenthesis?

Eph 3:1 For this reason I, Paul, **a prisoner for Christ Jesus** on behalf of you Gentiles— **Eph 3:13** So I ask you not to lose heart over **what I am suffering** for you, which is your glory.

- Paul wants his readers not to be concerned about trivial things such as "circumstances"
 - I am a prisoner and I am suffering, BUT I AM A PRISONER, NOT OF ROME BUT OF THE LORD JESUS CHRIST
 - I am a prisoner and I am suffering, BUT I DO NOT LOSE HEART OVER A TRIVIAL THING SUCH AS IMPRISONMENT BECAUSE I KNOW WHO THE LORD IS, WHO I AM IN CHRIST, AND WHAT I POSSESS
- He wants believers to focus on what matters:
 - o The Lord
 - o Your relationship with Him
 - Who you are to Him—YOU ARE HIS INHERITANCE
 - What you have received from Him—YOU ARE BLESSED WITH INHERITANCE THAT REQUIRED EVEN THE POWER OF RESURRECTION FOR YOU TO RECEIVE
 - YOUR GLORY IS NOT IN YOUR ANXIETY AND SADNESS, NOR IS IT IN YOUR FOCUS ON WHAT I AM SUFFERING—YOUR GLORY IS THE VERY OPPOSITE, NOT IN YOUR EMOTIONAL STATE REGARDING EARTHLY CIRCUMSTANCES NOR IN YOUR CONCERN FOR MY IMPROSONMENT. YOU NEED TO FOCUS ON WHAT MATTERS.

 THIS IS SIMILAR TO THE LORD JESUS WHO WOULD NOT ALLOW THE WOMEN FROM DE SEJERUSALEM TO MOURN FOR HIM. "MOURN FOR YOURSELVES AND YOUR CHILDREN" — Do not mourn for me.

Ephesians 3: 1-13

- For this reason I, Paul, a prisoner for Christ Jesus on behalf of you Gentiles—
- assuming that you have heard of the stewardship of God's grace that was given to me for you,
- how the mystery was made known to me by revelation, as I have written briefly.
- When you read this, you can perceive my insight into the mystery of Christ,
- which was not made known to the sons of men in other generations as it has now been revealed to his holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit.
- This mystery is that the Gentiles are fellow heirs, members of the same body, and partakers of the promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel.
- Of this gospel I was made a minister according to the gift of God's grace, which was given me by the working of his power.
- To me, though I am the very least of all the saints, this grace was given, to preach to the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ,
- and to bring to light for everyone what is the plan of the mystery hidden for ages in God who created all things,
- so that through the church the manifold wisdom of God might now be made known to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly places.
- This was according to the eternal purpose that he has realized in Christ Jesus our Lord, in whom we have boldness and access with confidence through our faith in him. So I ask you not to lose heart over what I am suffering for you, which is your glory.

Paul's Stewardship (Eph. 3:2)

God's arrangement concerning the grace of God that was given to the apostle Paul.

Paul defends this administration/dispensation in Galatians chapter 2 mentioning:

- Those who were influential in Jerusalem (the so-called "pillars"), namely James, Peter and John (Galatians 2: 9) added nothing to Paul's own commission (Galatians 2: 6)
- These "pillars" recognized that Paul had been entrusted with the gospel to the Gentiles, even as Pater was sent to the Jews (Galatians 2: 7)
- These influential men extended the "right hand of fellowship" to Paul (Galatians 2: 9)



What does "mystery" mean?

A secret hidden in the councils of the Godhead, revealed later:

Thus the mystery of the church that was not known to the "sons of men" in previous generations (Ephesians 3: 5) but is now revealed to his "holy apostles and prophets" (Ephesians 3: 5) and also made known to the Apostle Paul (Ephesians 3: 3) includes:

- The Church composed of both former Jewish and gentile believers in Christ,
- They together have become one new man (Ephesians 2: 15), , fellow citizens (Ephesians 2: 19), members of God's household (Ephesians 2: 19).
- They are also becoming a temple/"dwelling place for God in the Spirit" (Ephesians 2: 21-22)
- That the Gentiles in the church are fellow heirs, fellow members of the same body and fellow partakers of the promise even as Jewish believers (Ephesians 3: 6)

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WHAT IS THE MYSTERY?

Eph 3:6 This mystery is that the Gentiles are fellow heirs, members of the same body, and partakers of the promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel.

THE PEACE THAT WAS PROCURRED AT THE CROSS and THE FORMATION OF THE NEW MAN, THE BODY, THE BUILDING—composed of JEW and Gentile, IN CHRIST, also changed the status of privilege:

Now the believing GENTILE, as part of the BODY, BUILDING, BRIDE of CHRIST:

1. Are FELLOW HEIRS (thus inheritors)

Gal 3:29 And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's offspring, heirs according to promise.

2. Are FELLOW MEMBERS OF ONE BODY

1 Corinthians **12:12-13** For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ. For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body—Jews or Greeks, slaves or free—and all were made to drink of one Spirit.

3. Are FELLOW PARTAKERS OF THE PROMISE

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REVELATION OF THE MYSTERY

TO PAUL: (Ephesians 3: 3)

Directly by GOD—because He is chosen to be a steward

THE BELIEVERS APART FROM THE APOSTLES AND PROPHETS: (Ephesians 3: 7).

 By Paul, <u>through his writings</u>, having been made a minister according to the working of His grace, and the working of His power. Thus to us the REVELATION of God is the Scripture, the written document of holy writings (not direct revelation, which has ceased).

TO THE ANGELS (Ephesians 3: 10)

 Via the CHURCH—the Church is God's showcase, the object lesson, with God displaying his multi-colored and various layered wisdom to the angelic world, in what He has accomplished in God's citizens, God's household (family), God's building, Christ's body, Christ's bride (all of these are references to the church)

Eph 3:10 so that through the church the manifold wisdom of God might now be made known to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly places.
